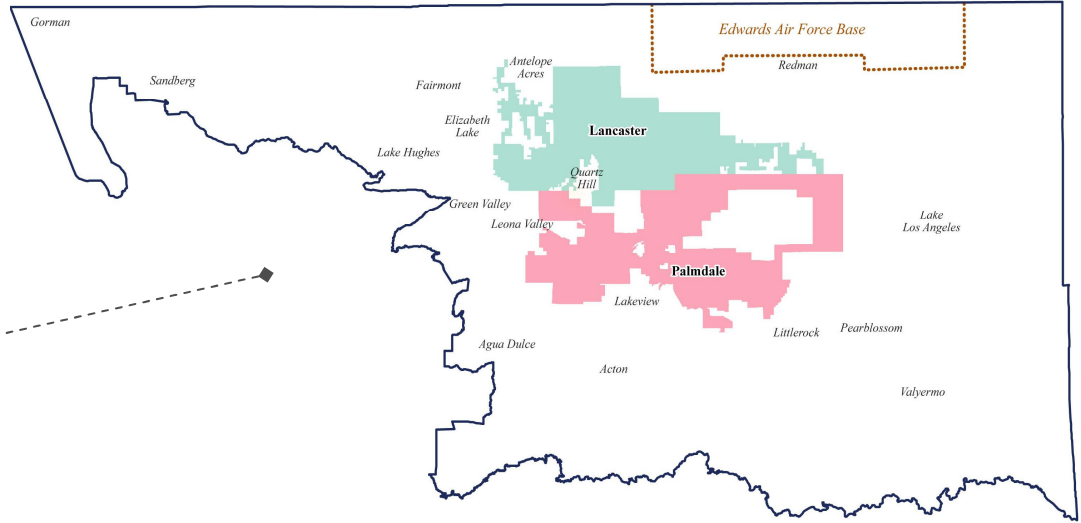


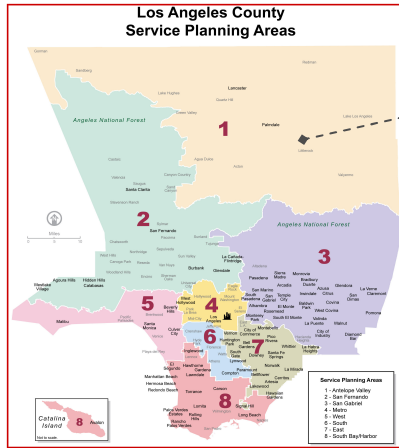

SERVICE PLANNING AREA I- ANTELOPE VALLEY

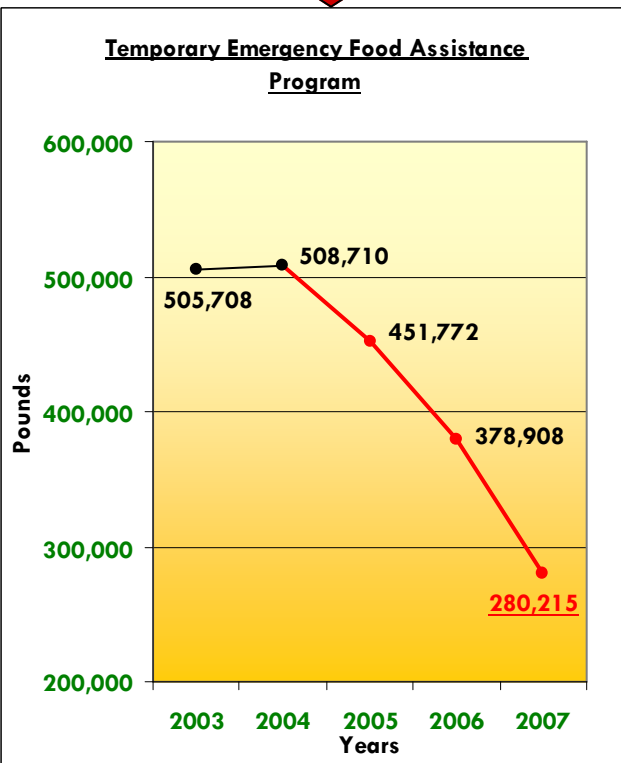

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS



- Food Industry:** Food Industry includes: local product donations, local salvage donations from major retailers, America's Second Harvest *national* donations, Extra Helpings, food banks and food drives.
- TEFAP:** The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) distributes commodities to food banks and hunger relief organizations through TEFAP.
- CSFP:** The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) distributes commodities to a small number of food banks and other agencies nationwide that in turn assemble food kits for distribution to senior citizens, young children or pregnant women.
- Shop-Smart-and-Save:** Shop Smart and Save offers retail and food service size products to agencies at well below retail and even wholesale club prices, allowing agencies to make better use of resources.
- BackPack:** The BackPack program provides school aged children with groceries to prepare six meals through the weekend.
- FEMA:** Through the direction of FEMA, a local board provides emergency food and shelter grants to local agencies. The Foodbank utilizes these funds to purchase staple food items.
- Power Pack:** The Power Pack program provides a snack to children participating in an agency sponsored after school program.
- Summer Lunch:** The Summer Lunch program provides a summer lunch to children participating at an agency sponsored site.
- Brown Bag:** Our Brown Bag program provides agency sites with food to be distributed to low income seniors.
- Emergency:** During a disaster, the Foodbank provides food to local agencies.
