Letter From the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank Board Chair and President

Dear Friends of the Food Bank,

During 2022, the Food Bank responded to numerous challenges that kept the demand for food assistance from families and individuals throughout Los Angeles County at a high level. Thanks to the strong support of food, volunteer, in-kind and financial contributions, the Food Bank was able to reach an average of more than 800,000 people every month throughout 2022.

Working with many partners, the Food Bank distributed more than 110 million pounds of food and product, valued at \$200+ million, to millions of families, older adults, children and individuals seeking assistance. The goal of our collective efforts is to ensure that our neighbors do not experience the devastating impact of hunger.

The Food Bank's Nutrition Education, CalFresh Outreach, Children's Nutrition and Senior Nutrition programs expanded their reach and service during 2022 thanks to increased financial support for these programs. The Food Bank also expanded its Diaper Program and Menstrual Products Program in order to provide additional essential resources to people throughout Los Angeles County.

During 2022, the Food Bank continued to increase the capacity of our more than 600 partner agencies by purchasing refrigerated vans and trucks, commercial refrigerators and freezers, and other equipment needed for their sites. This increased capacity allows our agency partners to acquire, store and distribute more perishable, frozen, and other foods helping more people seeking food assistance in their community. Our Extra Helpings Program continues to be an efficient food recovery model for our agency partners to access nutritious food in their neighborhoods and distribute the food to people in need.

In 2019, the Food Bank launched a Comprehensive Campaign to pay for the acquisition of a building in the City of Industry, the building improvements required for the building, and the Food Bank's ongoing operations and programs. We surpassed the four-year \$165 million goal in late 2022, raising \$177 million. The Industry building has been critical to our response to the pandemic. Once we complete the installation of the refrigeration and make other improvements, the building will significantly increase the Food Bank's capacity to serve the community for years to come.

We are heartened that we live in a place that is the home of so many generous people like you who have made hunger relief a priority, giving those in our community hope for a better and brighter future. Thank you for your support of the Food Bank as we continue to mobilize resources to fight hunger in our community.

Fighting Hunger Amid Rising Prices

The new normal of food insecurity in LA County.

High levels of inflation in 2022 made life more challenging for vulnerable communities in Los Angeles County, which were still recovering from the COVID-19 pandemic and related economic fallout. With prices rising across the board, essential items such as food, utilities and housing have become increasingly unaffordable for those who are already struggling to make ends meet. This results in an elevated need for budgetary relief, as families have to choose between paying for basic necessities and putting food on the table. Inflation has created an additional layer of financial stress for individuals and families, exacerbating the existing economic challenges faced by low-income and underserved communities.

Nurturing Future Generations

Mayo Elementary works with the Food Bank to fight hunger outside of the classroom.

The Los Angeles Regional Food Bank's Backpack Program helps fight child hunger by providing food to students and their families after school. When students have good food to eat, their academic performance, behavior and overall health are positively impacted.



Students who are more comfortable and well nourished are always going to be more receptive to being in the classroom and more focused on the work.

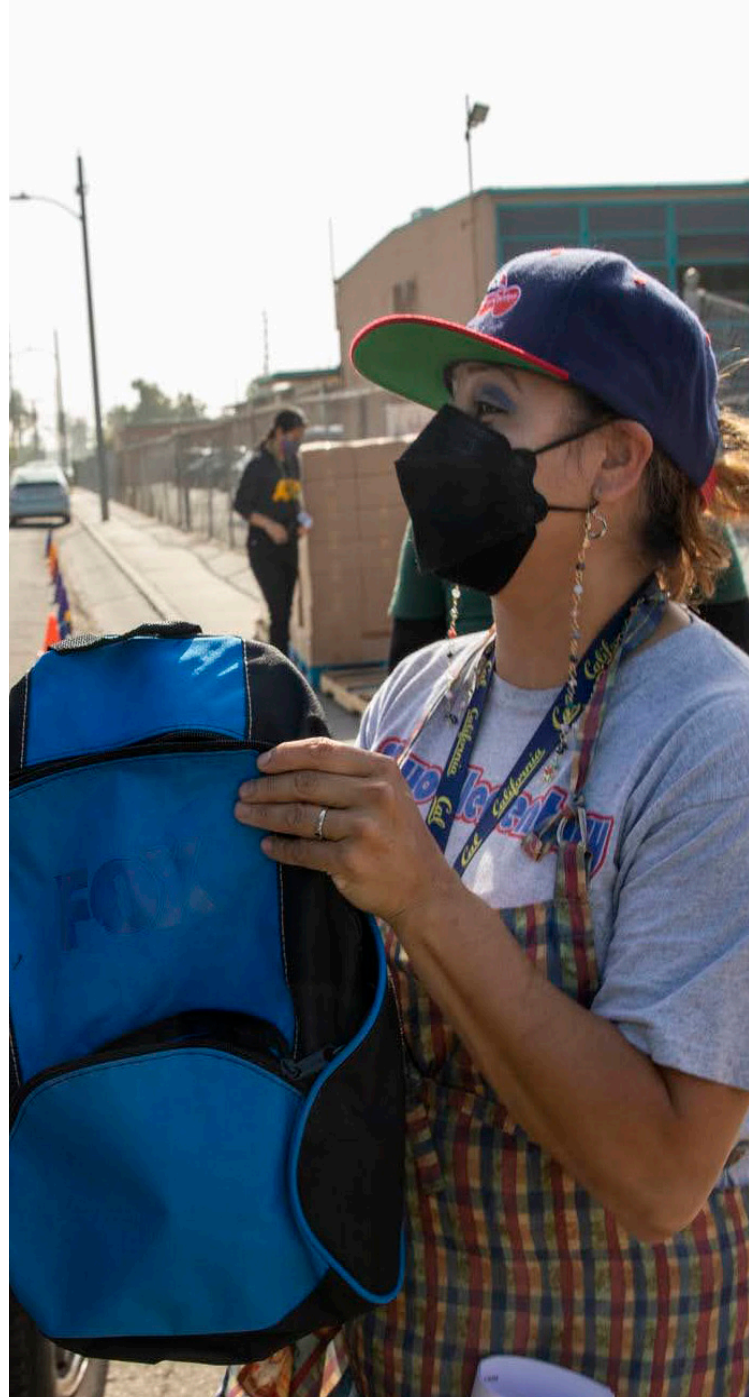

The Backpack Program

The Backpack Program is just one of the many food assistance programs the LA Regional Food Bank provides. An estimated 24% of the Food Bank's food goes to children. Other programs include the After School Meal Program, the Children's Breakfast Program, and the Summer Lunch and Breakfast programs. Children also benefit from the Mobile Food Pantry and the distributions at Food Bank partner agencies.

Fox Corporation

Since 1963, Los Angeles Regional Food Bank partner agency, the Mexican American Opportunity Foundation (MAOF), has been serving the Los Angeles community through services ranging from early childhood to senior services.

As a senior living on a fixed income, Maria Perez can't afford the hike in price for something as simple as napkins. Something she used to purchase for \$0.99 now costs \$2.99. Every time she has to go to the grocery store, she panics as she knows there'll be something new she can't purchase. Supporting the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank helps people like Maria access basic necessities.

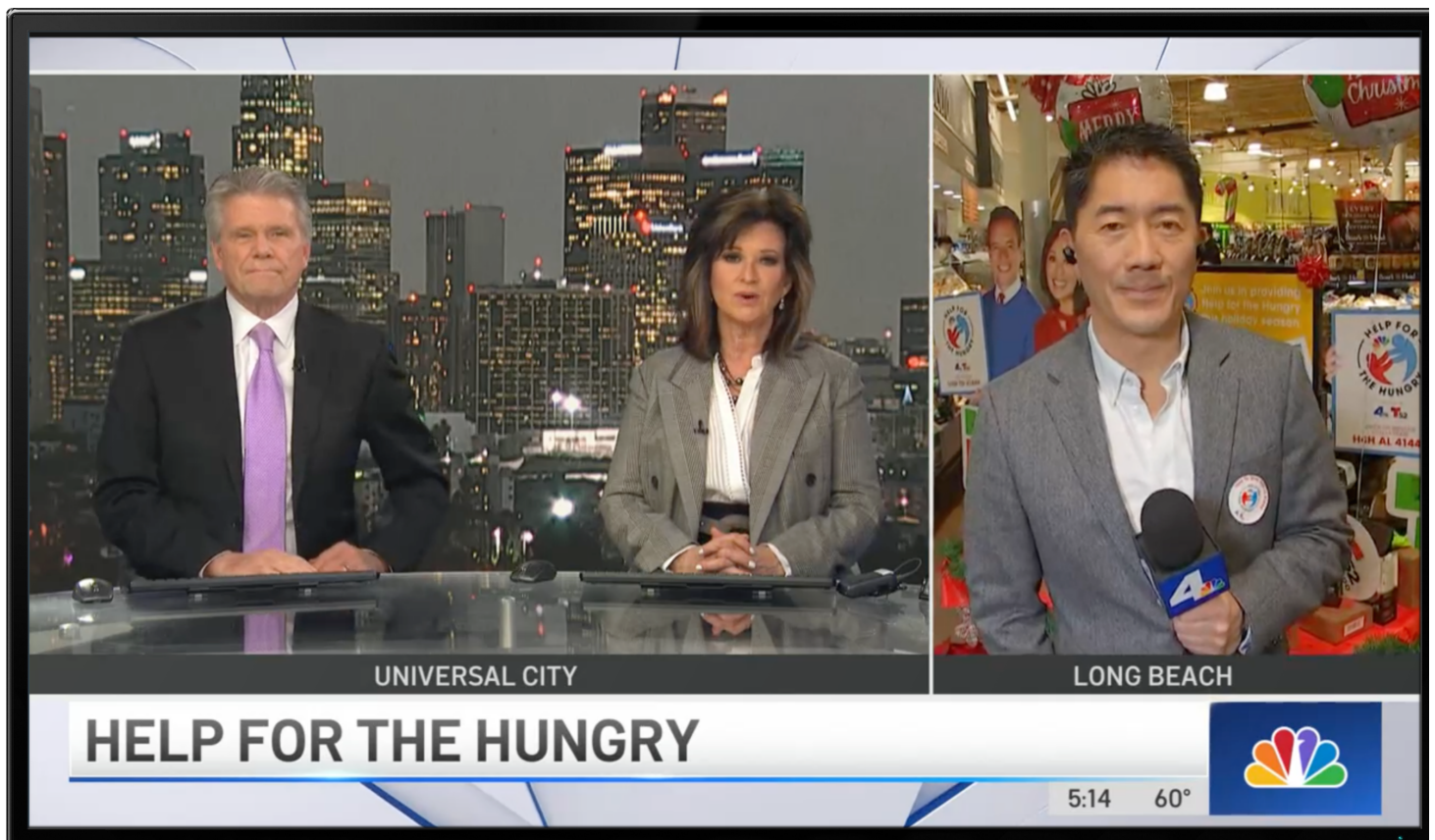


KTLA 5 Live Food Drive

Campaign Update

In 2022, the Los Angeles Regional Food Bank exceeded the ambitious Building Hope campaign goal of \$165 million, raising \$177 million. The success of the campaign allows the Food Bank to expand programs, renovate the City of Industry distribution center, reduce food waste and increase food distribution efforts. The new facility enables the Food Bank to expand its services and better serve those in need well into the future. The campaign received donations from a wide range of individuals and organizations, including corporations, foundations and philanthropists. The new facility will be equipped with

state-of-the-art technology to glean and package food for later distribution throughout LA County.

The successful completion of the campaign could not have been possible without the incredible support from the Food Bank's Board of Directors, the Building Hope Campaign Committee and a community of very generous donors. Building Hope represents a major step forward in the fight against hunger in Los Angeles.

Antelope Valley Partners for Health: Elevating Community Spirit

Antelope Valley Partners for Health (AVPH) is a vital community-based organization that has been working tirelessly to improve the health and well-being of Antelope Valley residents, despite the challenges posed by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

AVPH, like many of the Food Bank's partner agencies, provides food assistance to older adults who were disproportionately impacted by inflation. Many seniors are on fixed incomes, so as the cost of goods and services rises, their fixed income may no longer be sufficient to cover their expenses, leaving them struggling to make ends meet. Seniors often have higher healthcare costs than younger adults, and healthcare costs have been rising faster than the rate of inflation in recent years. In Los Angeles County, where the cost of living is already high, this can be an even greater burden for seniors.

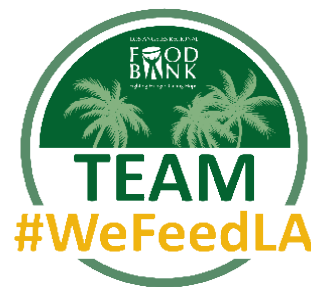

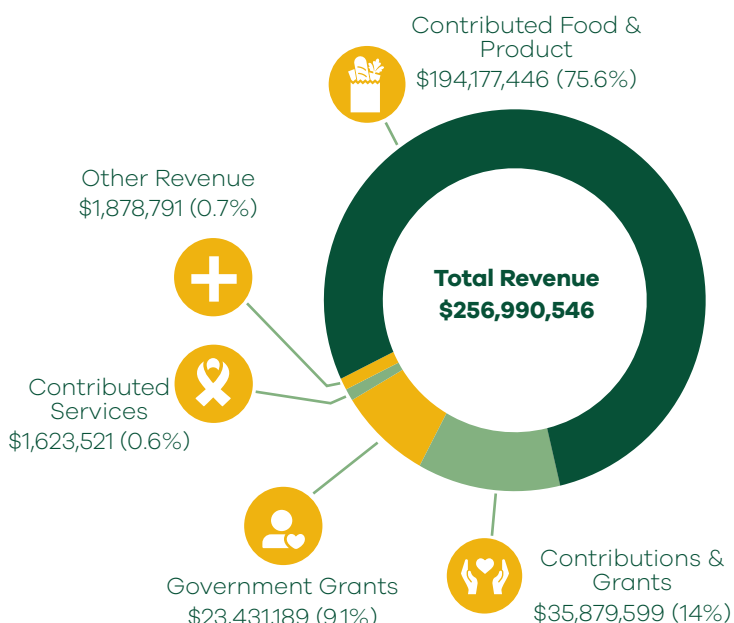
