
SUMMER LUNCH




SFSP gives hope to kids in need.

- SFSP provides free summer meals for children at risk of hunger.
- For summer sites, save up to \$150 per child.
- Free delivery.
- This program supports physical and social development when school it not in session.
- Help children and teenagers return to school ready to learn and succeed!

Who can apply?

- Organization must be a 501C3 non-profit.
- Services must be offered in a safe location such as a park, school, church, library, community center, etc.
- Organizations must operate in a low-income area for at least 15 days.
- Organization must obtain a CA Food Handler Certificate.
- Attend one mandatory two-hour Summer Lunch training session.
- Serve a minimum of 40 children per day.
- Serve children and teenagers under the age of 18.
